

## Prayer for Satisfaction in God

Thank you Father that You are the only source of true satisfaction. Nothing else can never provide the lasting satisfaction that we crave. Your servant Isaiah declared this with the words "Why do you spend money for what is not bread, and your wages for what does not satisfy? Listen carefully to Me, and eat what is good, and let your soul delight itself in abundance. Incline your ear, and come to Me. Hear, and your soul shall live.." Jesus declared this too with the words "Man shall not live by bread alone, but by every word of God".

Thank you Lord that You long to satisfy us with the fullness of who You are, as declared by the psalmist "They are abundantly satisfied with the fullness of Your house.."; and by Jeremiah "I will satiate the soul of the priests with abundance, and my people shall be satisfied with My goodness". Lord we see that the level of our hunger for You can limit Your ability to do this, as expressed in Psalm 107 "For He satisfies the longing soul, and fills the hungry soul with goodness". Father we ask You for the passion of Moses whose prayer was "Please, show me Your glory". In Isaiah 58 we also see a connection between our joy and satisfaction, and our willingness to extend our souls to satisfy the needs of others. Lord we ask You to enlarge our hearts to see and respond with compassion to the needs of others around us.

Thank you Father that as we let You transform us into Your image from day to day our satisfaction in You will grow. We see this in the words of Psalm 17 "As for me, I will see Your face in righteousness; I shall be satisfied when I awake in Your likeness". Jesus expressed this in John 15 with the words "These things I have spoken to you, that My joy may remain in you, and that your joy may be full". Lord we re-dedicate ourselves afresh to You today. We love You Lord. Amen.
